The application process for this initiative is open until **September 15, 2015**. The selected applicants who successfully complete the hiring process for these positions will be required to complete a Ten (10) week Maine State Police training course anticipated to begin in February 2016. Upon graduation and completion of the field training program, the applicants will be assigned to the specific patrol area for which they were hired.
