

**PLAN OF TERMINATION FOR AOS 66  
EAST MILLINOCKET/MEDWAY/WOODVILLE**

This Plan of Termination, subject to approval by the Commissioner of the Maine Department of Education and approval by the voters of one of more of the member school units within Alternate Organizational Structure No. 66 ("AOS 66"), terminates the Interlocal Agreement for Alternate Organizational Structure, dated May 4, 2011, between the East Millinocket School Department, the Medway School Department, and the Woodville School Department (the "Agreement") in accordance with its terms, effective June 30, 2014.

**Transition of School Administration**

Upon the effective date of termination, the East Millinocket School Department, the Medway School Department, and the Woodville School Department (collectively, the "Member School Units") shall continue to operate as independent municipal school units, and each shall provide for their own central office services as they did prior to July 1, 2011.

The Superintendent/Transportation Coordinator and the business manager are under contract with the AOS Board through June 30, 2015, and through those contracts are employed by the Member School Units. For the period of July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2015, the Superintendent/Transportation Coordinator will perform services for the School Units substantially on the terms of his current contract with the AOS Board. The Superintendent/Transportation Coordinator's salary and benefits shall be paid as follows. The East Millinocket School Department shall pay 55% of the salary and benefits; the Medway School Department shall pay 40% of the salary and benefits, and the East Millinocket School Department also shall pay 5% of the salary and benefits as fiscal agent for the Woodville School Department.

The AOS contracts for the secretary, and payroll clerk do not extend beyond June 30, 2014. After June 30, 2014, the Member School Units shall be responsible for their own services provided by these positions. The AOS has no other employees.


**AOS Employee Assignments**

The AOS has no employees to be assigned.

**Distribution of AOS Assets and Liabilities**

The AOS owns no real property and has no real property interest in its office space in East Millinocket High School. The occupancy rights of the AOS to such office space shall terminate as of June 30, 2014. All property interest in the furniture used by the AOS in said office space shall revert to the East Millinocket School Department. The photocopier under lease from Ricoh for use by the Superintendent shall continue to be used by the Superintendent, and the lease shall be assigned to or assumed by one or more of the Member School Units with the East Millinocket School Department responsible for 55% of the cost of the lease; the Medway School Department responsible for 40% of the cost of the lease, and the East Millinocket School Department also responsible for 5% of the cost of the lease as fiscal agent for the Woodville School Department. The AOS owns no other personal property. The AOS has no other debts, contracts, or other liabilities.




