Dear Superintendent Keenan:

Thank you for your letter dated March 24, 2008 in which you provided an update on the status of Easton School Department's efforts toward school administrative reorganization.

As you know, the 123rd Legislature ended its session on April 18, 2008. Although the legislation enacted regarding school administrative reorganization does not go into effect until July 18, 2008, Sec. 31. of PL 2007, chapter 240, Part XXXX, Section 36, subsection 6, A-1, permits me to authorize a unit to serve 1,200 or fewer students but not less than 1,000 in an isolated rural community. Therefore, I am approving the Notice of Intent filed by Bridgewater, Easton, MSAD 42 and MSAD 45 so that you may immediately begin your work toward filing a reorganization plan.

I encourage you to request a facilitator, paid for by the Department, to assist in your work as you proceed. Please submit your Reorganization Plan Submittal Sheet, Reorganization Plan Cover Sheet (checklist), and Reorganization Plan by Friday, June 13, 2008.
