1. William C. Collins, House District 27 Candidate, Request for Reconsideration: By letter dated October 17, 2002, Christopher C. Taintor, Esq., on behalf of Mr. Collins, requested the Commission to reconsider its decision made at its meeting of October 2, 2002, that Mr. Collins is not entitled to matching funds under the Maine Clean Election Act as of that date. The letter includes a request for a full evidentiary hearing to be held at which the Commission is requested to obtain and receive evidence concerning the purposes of certain expenditures made by Representative Kevin Glynn on and before June 11, 2002. Further, the Commission is requested to make specific findings of fact concerning whether those expenditures were made for the purpose of influencing the general election, in which case if so found, the Commission is requested to distribute matching funds to Mr. Collins based upon those expenditures by his opponent, Representative Glynn.
