Instructions

Maine Law provides that a resident over 10 years of age and any member of his immediate family over 10 years of age may hunt without a license on any single plot of land provided that the following conditions are met: (1) they are legally entitled to possess the land; 2 they are domiciled on the land; (3) the land is used exclusively for agricultural purposes, and (4) the land is in excess of 10 acres.

If you meet these qualifications, do not possess a valid hunting license and would like to participate in the drawing for Any-Deer Permits, you may qualify with this affidavit.

<u>Complete the affidavit on the other side and attach it to your filled-out Any-Deer Permit</u>

<u>Application.</u> Be sure to review the current Any-Deer Application carefully before completing.

You may only apply in the district in which your land is located.

PLEASE NOTE: If your application is drawn, the Any Deer Permit you are issued will only be good for your own land within the district even if you later buy a hunting license. If you want to apply for Any-Deer Permit valid anywhere in the district in which you live or for another district, you must purchase a hunting license prior to applying.
