Area - 297 acres

Maximum depth - 37 feet

Temperatures: Surface - 69⁰F 37 feet - 48⁰F

Principal fisheries: Smallmouth bass, largemouth bass, chain pickerel

A preponderance of warmwater fish species and an oxygen deficiency in the deeper cool water precludes David Pond from coldwater fishery management. Anglers catch the occasional brook trout or splake a result of drop downs from Basin Pond, which is stocked annually.
