Area - 18 acres

Maximum depth - 37 feet

Temperatures: Surface - 72<sup>0</sup>F 35 feet - 40<sup>0</sup>F

Principal fisheries: Smallmouth bass, chain pickerel

Davis Pond is a small heavily wooded and lightly developed pond by Central Maine standards. An acute oxygen deficiency exists below 10 feet during the warm summer months. This precludes stocking coldwater sport fish. Anglers have reported catching the occasional brook trout, but the warmwater species provide the majority of the sport fishery.
