Deer Pond is a small, shallow pond surrounded by softwood growth. Trout are reported to be present, but none were taken in the survey collections. Water temperatures probably do not reach the critical level for trout except during very hot weather. Spring areas are limited.

Tributary or lake spawning areas for trout are very limited, and the outlet is blocked by numerous beaver dams which prevent immigration of trout from the outlet.


Deer Pond is accessible by an unimproved gravel logging road.
