

Principal fishery: Chain pickerel

Welhern Pond is located between Eustis Ridge and Tim Brook. Much of the pond is less than ten feet deep, and its water quality is marginal for coldwater fish. A well-established population of chain pickerel competes heavily with the small number of brook trout present. For this reason, the pond is managed for chain pickerel, which are self-sustaining.
