

Suggested Management

Although landlocked salmon and brook trout are reported to occur in Mountainy Pond, a consideration of its water quality (warm at all depths) and existing fish populations (primarily bass, perch, and pickerel) indicates that management should be for the warm-water game species.

No attempt should be made to maintain salmon or trout populations either by habitat improvement or by stocking, for the lake will be more valuable as a natural resource, both economically and biologically, if managed for the more productive, better suited, warm-water species.
