

Noyes Pond is known locally as a trout pond. The survey findings reveal that the trout here must congregate in shallow water spring holes during summer months for the deeper cool waters are very low in dissolved oxygen.

The outlet, Peters Brook, has good spawning and nursery area and supports a trout population. The beaver dam at the outlet should be removed and the outlet kept free of obstructions to permit movement of trout back and forth between brook and pond.

Stocking is not needed because the outlet produces enough trout to stock the pond naturally under usual conditions.
