**Little Moose Pond is a shallow pond that is ideally suited for warmwater fisheries management. There is a lot of aquatic vegetation, which provides cover for both adult fish and forage fish. Largemouth bass are very abundant and fish up to 4 pounds are not uncommon.**

**Access is restricted to permissive trespass along a dirt road off Route 117.**


