

Current GOC Mission Statement

The mission of the Joint Legislative Committee on Program Evaluation and Government Accountability, hereafter called the “Committee”, is to ensure that public funds are expended in the most effective, efficient and economical manner possible. The Committee also seeks to ensure that such funds are used to support activities and functions that produce satisfactory results and that comply with State and Federal mandates. The Committee shall accomplish this mission by directing the Office of Program Evaluation and Government Accountability, hereafter called the “Office”, to conduct independent evaluations and investigations of State agencies and programs and, as necessary, of other entities receiving public funds or expending private monies for public purposes.

Draft Revision of GOC Mission Statement

The mission of the joint legislative Government Oversight Committee, hereafter called the “Committee”, is to oversee program evaluation and government accountability matters in State government. The Committee seeks to ensure that public funds are expended for intended purposes, and that programs and activities are effectively, efficiently and economically managed. The Committee accomplishes this mission by conducting public inquiries and directing the Office of Program Evaluation and Government Accountability to conduct independent, objective reviews of State agencies and programs and other entities receiving public funds or expending private monies for public purposes.
