

## **Juniper Ridge Landfill List of Submittals 6/22/2012**

February 22, 2012 Request for OPEGA review of issues involving Juniper Ridge Landfill signed by 10 Legislators.

March 9, 2012 letter from Michael Reynolds, member of the public, submittal for March 9, 2012 GOC meeting.

Reiterates and adds additional detail to points made in review request. Additional concerns over pollution monitoring.

March 11, 2012 e-mail from Charles Leithiser, member of the public.

Responding to the March 9, 2012 GOC meeting in which JRL was first discussed, description of avenues already explored by citizens.

March 16, 2012 Letter from the GOC to the Natural Resources Committee asking if they had concerns with the issues raised in the review request.

March 30, 2012 Letter from Edward Spencer, member of the public.

Responding to the March 9, 2012 GOC meeting in which JRL was first discussed, described his efforts and perspective over the course of JRL's history.

May 2, 2012 Letter from Juniper Ridge Landfill Advisory Committee (JRLAC)-Peter Dufour

Disputes Senator Saviello's statement on landfill expansion during April 12, 2012 GOC meeting.

Disputes Senator Saviello's statement regarding lack of complaints from JRLAC during April 12, 2012 GOC meeting, and says that the State, Casella & SPO often challenge the standing of the JRLAC rather than discuss issues.

May 15, 2012. Packet of info from Pierce Atwood, representing Casella Waste Responses to the 7 points of the original review request.

Timeline of public comment opportunities from May 2003.

Statement letter from Don Meagher of Casella on issues raised in review request.

Memo from the Legislature's Natural Resources Committee summarizing its meetings during the Interim Study of Solid Waste Management Issues dated November 2010.

May 24, 2012 Letter from Senator Saviello

Clarified his oral statement to the GOC on April 12, 2012 regarding JRL expansion statement. He further explained that the expansion would be within the current footprint of the landfill and not require purchase of abutting land.

He states that out of state waste issue and the role of the Juniper Ridge Landfill Advisory Committee are both questions of policy.

May 24, 2012 Letter from Pierce Atwood, representing Casella Waste. Reiterates that there have been numerous opportunities for public comment, provides a summary of the 2010 Interim Study of Solid Waste Management Issues, and expresses agreement with Senator Saviello that the Government Oversight Committee has many, higher priorities.

May 25, 2012 Packet and Letter from Deborah Gibbs, member of the public. (the “blue folder”)

Printed excerpts from, and comments on, documents and e-mails obtained through FOAA request for the time period April 17, 2003 to January 22, 2004. The packet also contains a CD which includes the entirety of all the scanned documents. Gives a good picture of how the State came to own the landfill and how Casella came to be the operator.

June 13, 2012 Letter from Paul Schroeder, member of the public. Reiterates and adds additional detail to points made in review request.

June 13, 2010 Letter from Edward Spencer, member of the public. Disputes Senator Saviello’s statement on landfill expansion during April 12, 2012 GOC meeting. Reiterates and adds additional detail to points made in review request.
