

Contractors' RFP Construction Details Sebasticook Alewife Access Road --Town of Benton

This project is to build an access road from Clinton Avenue to a turnaround and parking area one hundred feet from the shore of the Sebasticook River and includes layout, clearing and grubbing, laying geotextile fabric, placing and grading of gravel and compacting.

- Clearing and chipping of brush and trees as necessary, trees removed to become contractor's property
- Building a 12' wide access road of 18" coarse material, <6" minus gravel over geotextile fabric
- Grubbing only where necessary, such material as well as any stumps and chips to be used for stabilizing disturbed soil or to be deposited in low areas,
- Finished grade 6" or more above existing
- South edge of the road to maintain 6 feet from boundary along the first 405' (the length of the 20 foot wide section)
- 15" by 20' culvert at the street
- one other culvert to allow natural flow of surface water where appropriate past the 20 foot wide section
- ditching as needed to drain toward the existing low areas on the northerly CMP transmission line land
- road to curve where needed to skirt existing borrow pits and minimize filling slopes or dips
- a turnout to allow two-way traffic, near the mid length of the road
- a gravel turnaround and parking area, approximately 30 by 30 feet at the eastern end, but no disturbance within 75 feet of shore

See detail maps for borrow pit areas. A site visit is recommended

CMP Pin at roadside marks N side of 20 foot r/w, with survey stake and flag marking south side (close to neighbor's driveway), survey stakes along south edge in line with a CMP pin 405 feet back (with visible red "witness post"). Another CMP "witness post" at the river marks the Town lot's NE corner.

Contractor to provide proof of insurance and workers' comp coverage.

Town to obtain needed permits; Town has had property surveyed. Town will provide stakes and flag entrance from Clinton Avenue.

Construction to be completed by October 1, 2009




