Attached please find the December 2010 MCILS Operation Report and FY 11, Quarter 2 Expense Report for your review and our discussion at the upcoming Commission meeting on January 11, 2010.

In the month of December:

- The number of rostered attorney rose to 423, representing 363 law firms.
- 2,358 new cases were opened in the DefenderData system.
- 2,009 vouchers were submitted electronically, with 1,740 paid totaling \$632,595.37.
- The number of paper vouchers submitted and paid was 52 totaling 67,651.89.
- Combined, there were 2,061 electronic and paper vouchers paid totaling \$700,247.26. The average amount per voucher was \$390.76.

In Quarter 2 of Fiscal Year 11:

- Our personnel expenses increased by 24% as we hired our Deputy Executive Director and two additional screeners for York and Cumberland County.
- We saw a 10% increase in our operating expenses, again mainly due to the increase in expenses due to the hiring of additional staff. Since the two screeners were not on payroll until the very end of this quarter, we anticipate an additional 10% - 15% increase in our operating expenses next quarter due to increased OIT expenses, employee mileage, cell phone use, etc. Now that we are fully staffed, the operating expenses should then stabilize between Quarters 3 and 4.
- We paid \$2,371,387.12 in indigent legal services, which includes counsel payments, expert witness fees, interpreters, PIs, processes servers and transcript fees.

Although not reflected in these standard monthly and quarterly reports, I also broke down the following data for your review:

- There was a 36% decrease in the number of cases opened in the online billing system from Quarter 1 (10,938 cases) to Quarter 2 (6,988 cases).
- There was a decrease of 87% in the number of paper vouchers submitted between Quarter 1 (1505 vouchers) and Quarter 2 (170 vouchers).
- Combined, the total paper and online voucher submissions decreased 11% from Quarter 1 (7,067) to Quarter 2 (6,306).
- The average voucher amount paid decreased 4% from Quarter 1 (\$403.23) to Quarter 2 (\$385.86).
- At the end of Quarter 1, we were roughly 2 weeks from submission of a voucher to review/payment. We maintained that AP schedule until the very end of Quarter 2, when we backed up to 3 weeks from submission to review/payment as we spent down our quarterly budget allotment. We started the new calendar year, and new Quarter 3 budget allotment, with no vouchers more than 3 weeks from submission date, and at this time are back on the 2 week review/payment schedule.
