A Mandatory Pre-Bid conference will be held on Tuesday, August 3, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. For those bidders not able to attend the August 3<sup>rd</sup> Pre-Bid Conference, a second Pre-Bid Conference will be held on Monday, August 9, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. The location will be at the Lewiston Public Services conference room, 103 Adams Ave, Lewiston, Maine. All prospective bidders are required to attend.

#### **General Description of Work:**

Milling of of pavement and a  $1 - \frac{1}{4}$  inch pavement overlay on Pine Street beginning at Canal Street and extending northeasterly 0.92 mi. to Sabattus Street.

The work shall be the complete and satisfactory furnishing and installing of approximately 1,470 tons of machine placed 9.5 mm Hot Mix Asphalt; 825 tons of machine place 9.5 mm Hot Mix Asphalt shim; 80 tons of 9.5 mm hand placed Hot Mix Asphalt for driveways; 8,700 square yards of pavement milling; 1,900 square yards of pavement butt joints; adjustment to 62 catch basins or manholes; 5,000 linear feet of white and yellow pavement marking lines; 2,400 square feet of pavement and curb markings; and all other incidental work as necessary to satisfactorily complete the project as outlined or implied in the Plans/Specifications.

The project also consists of hot mix asphalt sidewalk reconstruction on both sides of Pine Street beginning at Webster Street and extending northeasterly approximately 950 linear feet to Sabattus Street.

The work shall be the complete and satisfactory furnishing and installing of approximately 785 square yards of machine place 9.5 mm Hot Mix Asphalt for sidewalks; 1,030 linear feet of Type I vertical granite curbing; 43 each of 7 feet long granite tipdown terminal curbing; 2 each ADA compliant sidewalk ramps fitted with Detectable Warning Plates; 40 linear feet of Type I radial granite curbing; and all other incidental work as necessary to satisfactorily complete the project as outlined or implied in the Plans/Specifications.

All materials and labor required to complete the work will be supplied by the Contractor unless otherwise provided for in the Supplemental Specifications. The cost and expense of all the necessary labor, tools and equipment required to complete the work shall be included in the prices stated in the Proposal.

A certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Lewiston or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and a Surety Company in the amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the Bid shall be submitted with

each bid. No bid may be withdrawn for at least 60 days after receipt of bids unless released by the City of Lewiston.

A performance Bond and Labor and Material Payment Bond, preferably executed in AIA Bond Form Number A311 in an amount equal to the total Contract price, of a surety company satisfactory to the Director of Budget/Purchasing, will be required of the successful bidder to ensure completion of the work and proper fulfillment of the conditions of the Contract. The total Contract price shall mean the total bid price as stated in the Bid based on the estimated quantities of the various items of work.

The Bidder's attention is called to the Supplemental Federal Conditions, Federal Labor Standard Provision and Wage Rate Schedule appended to these Contract Documents. Should a discrepancy exist between the Supplemental Federal Conditions, Federal Labor Standard Provisions and the Wage Rate Schedule and City's General Provisions, the requirements of the Supplemental Federal Conditions, Federal Labor Standard Provisions and Wage Rate Schedule shall apply.
