A Mandatory Pre-Bid conference will be held on Tuesday, June 2, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. The location will be at the Lewiston Public Services conference room, 103 Adams Ave, Lewiston, Maine. All prospective bidders are required to attend.

Highway Preservation Overlay (3/4" Overlay) on Main Street beginning at Lisbon Street and extending north .2 miles to Sabattus Street continuing on Main Street from Sabattus Street and extending .54 miles to Riverside Street and on East Avenue beginning at Sabattus Street and extending southerly 1.28 miles to Lisbon Street.

General Description of Work:

Sealed Proposals for Main Street & East Avenue Highway Preservation Overlay, which consists of the complete and satisfactory furnishing and installing of approximately 3,180 tons of machine placed 9.5 mm Hot Mix Asphalt, 1,840 tons of machine placed 4.75 mm Hot Mix Asphalt for shim, 145 tons of 9.5 mm hand placed Hot Mix Asphalt for driveways, 5,020 square yards of pavement butt joint, set to grade 101 catch basins or manholes, 36,550 feet of white and yellow pavement marking line, 8,750 square feet of pavement and curb marking and all other structures and incidental work as necessary to satisfactorily complete the Project as outlined or implied in the Plans and Specifications

All materials and labor required to complete the work will be supplied by the Contractor unless otherwise provided for in the Supplemental Specifications. The cost and expense of all the necessary labor, tools and equipment required to complete the work shall be included in the prices stated in the Proposal.

A certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Lewiston or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and a Surety Company in the amount equal to **ten percent** (10%) of the Bid shall be submitted with each bid. No bid may be withdrawn for at least 60 days after receipt of bids unless released by the City of Lewiston.

A Performance Bond and a Labor and Material Payment Bond, preferably executed on AIA Bond Form Number A311 in an amount equal to the total Contract price, of a surety company satisfactory to the Director of Budget/Purchasing, will be required of the successful bidder to ensure completion of the work and the proper fulfillment of the conditions of the Contract. The total Contract price shall mean the total bid price as stated in the Proposal based on the estimated quantities of the various items of work.

The Bidder's attention is called to the Supplemental Federal Conditions, Federal Labor Standard Provisions and the Wage Rate Schedule appended to these Contract Documents. Should a discrepancy exist between the Supplemental Federal Conditions, Federal Labor Standard Provisions and the Wage Rate Schedule and the City's General Provisions, the requirements of the

Supplemental Federal Conditions, Federal Labor Standard Provisions and the Wage Rate Schedule shall apply.
