The City of Waterville is seeking Bids for renovations to its historic Two Cent Bridge. The project will include the replacement of the horizontal wind cables, replacement of grating to comply with ADA standards, and removal and replacement of the existing railing system. A site inspection is scheduled for Thursday 22 July at 10:00 am. The project is located on East Temple Street in Waterville. Kleinschmidt Associates designed the renovations and will be assisting the City on technical issues related to the project.
