Dear Sir/Ms:

Make the following changes to the Bid Documents:

In the Bid Book; under "SPECIAL PROVISION, SECTION 510, SPECIAL DETOURS, **DELETE** in its entirety sections 510.04 (Pedestrian Traffic only, on pages 5 of 9 and 6 of 9) **AND** Section 510.05 (Vehicular and Pedestrian Traffic Separated, page 6 of 9). Make this change in pen and ink.

The following Questions have been received:

Question: Please clarify what the final riding surface of the "Maybey Bridge" deck surface is comprised of. Amendment #7 states that the top surface of the deck plate is to be coated with an anti-skid aggregate epoxy mixture, while page 6 of 9 of Special Provision 510, Special Detours, states that the riding surface of the special detour structure shall be either concrete or hot bituminous pavement. Is the deck surface of the Maybey Bridge required to be concrete or pavement?

**Response:** The Maybey Bridge deck plates need to be coated with an anti-skid aggregate mixture. The rest of the detour will be paved.

**Question:** Please clarify whether a 5 foot wide sidewalk is required on the Maybey Bridge structure, yes or no. If yes, does this requirement for a 5 foot sidewalk carry over to the approach roadway of the special detour as well? Presently no such sidewalk exists on the permanent approaches to the existing cribstone bridge.

**Response:** No sidewalk is needed on the temporary bridge.

Consider these changes and information prior to submitting your bid on May 21, 2008.
