Dear Sir/Ms:

Please make the following change to the Bid Document:

In the Bid Book (page 1), "NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS";

In the first sentence, **DELETE** the City of Gardiner, and Towns of Litchfield, West Gardiner. The Town of Monmouth shall remain.

DELETE in its entirety, the paragraph following "Description:" and **REPLACE** with the following; "Description: State Project Pin 012671.01".

DELETE in its entirety the paragraph labeled "Location:" and REPLACE with the following; "Location: In Kennebec County the project is located in Monmouth, beginning 0.10 miles easterly of the Wales town line and extending easterly 0.75 mile to 0.50 mile easterly of Country Lane."

CHANGE the bid bond amount from \$65,000 to \$40,000. Make the above changes in pen and ink.

In the Bid Book (pages 3 through 12), **REMOVE** the "SCHEDULE OF ITEMS" (10 pages, dated 080714) and **REPLACE** with the attached, new "SCHEDULE OF ITEMS" (7 pages dated 080808).

In the Bid Book (pages 13 through 20), **REMOVE** the "CONTRACT AGREEMENT, OFFER & AWARD", 2 copies, and **REPLACE** with the attached, new "CONTRACT AGREEMENT, OFFER & AWARD", 2 copies.

In the Bid Book, **DELETE** all pages referencing Litchfield (PIN 012754.00), Gardiner (PIN 015830.00), and Litchfield/West Gardiner (PIN 015831.00). This deletion includes all associated Special Provisions unless Monmouth (PIN 012671.01) is also referenced. Make this change in pen and ink.



In the Bid Book, (pages 58 through 60), **DELETE** in its entirety, "General Decision Number: ME080009 06/06/2008 ME9".

In the Bid Book, after page 90, **INSERT** the attached "SPECIAL PROVISION, SECTION 108, PRICE ADJUSTMENT FOR HOT MIX ASPHALT, (Asphalt Escalator), 1 page dated August 8, 2008...

In the Bid Book (pages 128 – 131), **REMOVE** "SPECIAL PROVISION, SECTION 403, HOT MIX ASPHALT OVERLAY", Alternate 1 for Monmouth (pages 128 & 129, dated July 14, 2008) <u>AND</u> Alternate 2 for Monmouth (pages 130 & 131, dated July 14, 2008). **REPLACE** with the attached new "SPECIAL PROVISION, SECTION 403, HOT MIX ASPHALT OVERLAY" Alternate 1 for Monmouth (2 pages, dated August 8, 2008) AND Alternate 2 for Monmouth (2 pages, dated August 8, 2008).

In the Plans, Plan Sheet 4 of 56, ESTIMATED QUANTITIES, **DELETE**, in its entirety ITEM NO 603.211. In its place, **ADD** ITEM NO "603.219", QUANTITY "58" and UNIT "LF". Make this change in pen and ink.

In the Plans, Plan Sheet 5 of 56, Under "STATION", "ROADWAY CULVERTS" (left side of sheet), **DELETE**, in it's entirety, STA. 436+25 RT and all it's associated notes and information. Make this change in pen and ink.

In the Plans, Plan Sheet 5 of 56, "DRIVEWAY CULVERTS", under "REMARKS", **DELETE** the remark associated with STA 436+25 RT ("REPLACE EXISTING") and **REPLACE** with the following remark, "OUTLET FROM C.B. #2 AND CONNECT TO U.D.". Make this change in pen and ink.

In the Plans, Plan Sheet 5 of 56, STATION, ROADWAY CULVERTS, STA. 450+54, under the "CMP" column **DELETE** "36"" under SIZE and "58" under LENGTH. Under "OPTION III" – "CORRUGATED" (same row), **ADD** under SIZE, "36"" and under LENGTH, "58". Under REMARKS (same row), **ADD** the following to the existing note "PIPE MUST BE CORRUGATED". Make this change in pen and ink.

In the Plans, Plan Sheet 6 of 56, in the diagram on the top of the sheet, **DELETE** the note under Sta. 436+25 RT +/- that reads "18" X 40' OPT. III" and REPLACE it with "18" X 40' OPT. I". Make this change in pen and ink.

In the Plans, Plan Sheet 8 of 56, in the diagram on the top of the sheet, **DELETE** the note next to Sta. 450+54 RT +/- that reads "36" X 58' CMP" and **REPLACE** with the following "36" X 58' OPT. III.". Make this change in pen and ink.

In the Plans (last 4 sheets), **DELETE** Plan Sheets 1 of 4 through 4 of 4 for the town of Litchfield. Make this change in pen and ink.

The following questions have been received:

Question: Special Provision, Section 403, Section for the Alternate 1 and 2 for Monmouth refers to note 7, there is no complimentary note to accompany this, what should the note be?

Response: Please refer to the changes made in this amendment.

Question: Will fuel escalation be considered for this project?

Response: Yes, please see the attached Special Provision.

Question: Is there an equation to relate stations cited in Special Provision, Section 203, Contaminated Soil, to the stations on the plans?

Response: Please refer to Amendment #1
