The following question has been received:

**Question:** Concerning the cofferdam requirements, is sheetpiling a requirement or are we able to fashion another way to redirect the water?

**Response:** Installation of sheetpiling is not a requirement for payment of a cofferdam. Other acceptable methods include a stream diversion or sand bags in appropriate situations. Cofferdam installation shall be in accordance with the contract specifications including Special Provision, Section 656, Temporary Soil Erosion and Water Pollution Control.
