The following questions have been received.

Question: Does the entire concrete slab receive paint or just inside the building?

Response: The only part of the concrete slab to be painted is the floor inside the building.

Question: If work is performed off site, would the wage rates where the work is being done apply or would the wage rates at the privy site location apply?

Response: The wage rates for the privy site location would apply.

Question: The wage rates for carpenters in Franklin, Oxford and York counties appear unreasonable, are these rates correct?

Response: Yes, the supplied rates for these counties are accurate.

Question: There aren't any wage rates listed for carpenters in Cumberland and Penobscot counties, do we use labor rates?




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Response: A carpenter rate for these counties will have to be requested from the Department of Labor by the Contractor after award.
