In the Bid Book (pages 4 thru 11), **REMOVE** the "SCHEDULE OF ITEMS", 8 pages dated 100521 and **REPLACE** with the attached new "SCHEDULE OF ITEMS", 9 pages dated 100622.

In the Bid Book (pages 12 thru 19), **REMOVE** the "CONTRACT AGREEMENT, OFFER & AWARD", both copies and **REPLACE** with the attached new "CONTRACT AGREEMENT, OFFER & AWARD", 2 copies (8 pages total).

Question: Item 526.30, Temporary Concrete Barrier 108 LF, standard barrier is 10' long, how do you come up with 108'?

Response: The 108' length is for estimating purposes only.

The Department and the Contractor, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this Agreement (the "Contract"), hereby agree as follows:

A. The Work.
