**Question:** Who is responsible for disconnecting the existing electric meter? **Response:** MaineDOT will have the power shut off as part of demolition.

**Question:** Who is responsible for the temporary power pedestal?

**Response:** The contractor is responsible for the temporary power pedestal.

**Question:** Who is responsible for energy costs during construction?

Response: The contractor is responsible for any power costs until the building is

accepted by MaineDOT.

Question: Who is responsible for Central Maine Power Co. charges?

Response: The contractor is responsible for any fees charged by CMP to reconnect

power.

**Question:** Who is responsible for signage, what type and where?

Response: The contractor is NOT responsible for any signs; MaineDOT will install any

required notification signs.
