The following questions have been received:

Question: Special Provision 107, page 82, Note 8 calls for night work from station 10+00 to station 91+57. Will the Contractor be allowed to perform peripheral work (curbing, catch basin adjustments, sidewalk construction, etc.) during the daytime by utilizing shoulder closures?

Response: All work between 10++ and 91+57 will be done at night as specified.

Question: Can you provide information on how the removal of pavement and excavation of sidewalks in areas of Type I curb removal and resetting will be paid for?

Response: Removal of pavement and excavation of sidewalk in Type I curb removal and reset areas will be paid as common excavation. Backfill behind the reset curb will be paid as ASCG and repaving of sidewalk will be paid for under appropriate paving item. Limits of excavation of sidewalks in the curb reset areas will be established in the field by the resident.

Question: The embedded wage rates had no flagger rates. Amendment #1 also had no wage rates for flaggers. Please provide flagger wage rates for this project.
