Make the following change to the Bid Document:

In the Bid Book (page 41), **REMOVE** the "2010 Fair Minimum Wage Rates", 1 page with a filing date of June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 and **REPLACE** with the attached, corrected "2010 Fair Minimum Wage Rates" 1 page with a filing date of June 16, 2010.

The following questions have been received:

**Question:** In reviewing the specifications for the project, I noticed that you include the 2010 Fair Minimum Wage Rates for Cumberland County. Shouldn't the wage rates reflect Sagadahoc County?

Response: Please see the attached new Wage Rates.

**Question:** Can you confirm this is a State project only and thus MBE/WBE goals are not required on this project?

**Response:** DBE goals are not applicable to this project.

**Question:** Will milling be permitted on the bridge deck on RT 196 over US 295? Is the pavement 2" like on RT 201?

**Response:** No cores have been taken. The successful bidder will be asked to take cores to determine a milling depth which will not exceed 2".

**Question:** Many of Topsham's intersections now have cameras and not loop detectors, are the 39 detectors actually needed? On the RT 201 project, the loops were changed to camera's which is what Topsham is doing on most of the intersections.



**Response:** The milling operation is expected to remove all 39 detectors. Cameras are not planned at this time.

Consider this change and information prior to submitting your bid on June 30, 2010.

Welders are classified in the trade to which the welding is incidental.

Apprentices - The minimum wage rate for registered apprentices are those set forth in the standards and policies of the Maine State Apprenticeship and Training Council for approved apprenticeship programs.

Posting of Schedule - Posting of this schedule is required in accordance with 26 MRSA §1301 et. seq., by any contractor holding a State contract for construction valued at \$50,000 or more and any subcontractors to such a contractor.

Appeal - Any person affected by the determination of these rates may appeal to the Commissioner of Labor by filing a written notice with the Commissioner stating the specific grounds of the objection within ten (10) days from the filing of these rates with the Secretary of State.
