

**STATE OF MAINE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**

The Maine Department of Environmental Protection, through the Maine Department of Transportation, will be advertising for the remediation of the Callahan Mine Superfund Site in Brooksville. The work shall consist of excavating contaminated material, debris removal, stockpiling, off-site disposal, and placement of a temporary cover on stockpiled material. Bids will be accepted from all bidders. The lowest responsive bidder must demonstrate successful completion of similar type projects and demonstrate certain qualifications relating to the safe excavation and handling of hazardous materials to be considered for the award of this contract.

A Mandatory Pre-Bid meeting is scheduled at the Callahan Mine Superfund Site. Interested parties should meet at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, December 8th, 2010 at the intersection of Harborside Road and Old Mines Road in Brooksville, Maine. Potential Bidders will be allowed to ask questions concerning the project and review the area of the proposed project.

General Scope of Work:

- Excavation and proper off-site disposal of soil contaminated with polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) exceeding site-specific cleanup levels within the former Mine Operation Area.
- Excavation and off-site disposal of Comprehensive Environmental Response and Liability Act (CERCLA) waste commingled with petroleum-contaminated soil exceeding site-specific cleanup levels within the former Mine Operation Area.
- Excavation of soil containing arsenic, thallium, and lead exceeding site-specific cleanup levels in the Residential Use Area of the Site.
