Section No. <u>R1-2</u>: Route 25 (Porter to Cornish), beginning at the Maine-NH state line (Node 34995, MP 42.01) and extending easterly to the junction of Route 5 in Cornish (Node 56949, MP 31.55), for an approximate length of 10.46 miles. Route 113, beginning at the junction of Route 5/117 (Node 15775, MP 12.08) and extending in a northwesterly direction to the Hiram town line (Node 34845, MP 15.68) for an approximate length of 3.60 miles.

Section No. <u>R1-3</u>: Route 5 (Limerick-Cornish), beginning at the northerly junction of Route 11 in Limerick (Node 55782, MP 29.07) and extending in a northerly direction to the junction of Route 25 (Node 56953, MP 37.85) for an approximate length of 8.78 miles. Route 5 (Cornish-Baldwin), beginning at the junction of Route 25 (Node 56949, MP 38.53) and extending northerly to the junction of Route 113 in Baldwin (Node 15775, MP 40.58) for an approximate length of 2.05 miles.

The initial term of this contract is for three winter seasons, beginning November 1 and ending May 1 of each year, beginning on November 1, 2008 and ending on May 1, 2011. The contract term may be extended for up to three additional years on the same terms by mutual agreement as provided by the Contract.
