SPECIAL PROVISION
SECTION 644
GLARE FOIL
(Repair and Replace)

Description This work consists of repair or replacing damaged or missing individual glare foils mounted on top of the permanent center median barrier within the work zone.

CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS

Glare Foil The glare foils shall consist of a vertical blade attached to the top of the median barrier and shall, as close as possible, be a match to the existing glare foils. Glare Foils shall be SAFE-HIT Glare Screen System (individual blade and base unit and fasteners) as manufactured by SAFE-HIT Corporation, 23785 Cabot Blvd., #322, Hayward, California 94545, (312) 467-6750, or equivalent as approved by the Resident.

Basis of Payment The quantity of Glare Foil – Repair and Replace, will be paid for at the contract unit bid price per Each. Payment shall include compensation for all labor material, equipment and incidentals necessary to complete the work.

There will be no separate payment for glare foils removed, but removal and disposal shall be considered incidental to applicable contract pay items.

Installation of the Glare Foils Final location of glare foils shall be approved by the Resident.

The Contractor shall note that it is the department's intention for glare foil installation to occur during the phase 3 when the adjacent lane will be closed, however, the contractor may perform this work on their timing, with Resident approval. All maintenance of traffic is incidental.

The Contractor shall operate in a manner which prevents damage to the glare foils during installation and removal. The Contractor shall be responsible for replacement and reinstallation of glare foils damaged during the Contractor's operations. No additional payment shall be made for replacement and reinstallation of glare foils damaged as a result of the Contractor's operations.
