HOGAN ROAD SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

MDOT PROJECT NUMBER STP-1848(600)X/1848(610)

The project includes the construction of a lengthened right turn lane on Bangor Mall Boulevard from Hogan Road to the Toys R Us Intersection to provide more vehicle storage and construct appropriated paved shoulder, along with relocating the sidewalk onto the left side of Bangor Mall Boulevard with new pedestrian crossing at the Toys R Us Intersection and other incidental work in Bangor, Maine.

The project also includes the construction of a right turn lane at the end of Hogan Road onto Stillwater Avenue, along with new curbing, stormdrain and other incidental work in Bangor, Maine.

The Hogan Road Safety Improvements Project is a Maine Federal Aid Project No. STP 1848(600)X, MDOT PIN 18486.00, located at the intersection of Hogan Road and Bangor Mall Boulevard and Maine Federal Aid Project No. STP 1848(610)X, MDOT PIN 18486.10, located at the intersection of Hogan Road and Stillwater Avenue, Bangor, Maine.

Bid security in the amount of 5% of the bid price will be required in the form of cash, a certified check or bid bond.

This project is subject to the Federal Labor Standards Provisions and Davis-Bacon Wage Rate Determination. All work shall be governed by State of Maine Department of Transportation, "Standard Specification", revision of December 2002, and "Standard Details", revision of December 2002.

The right is reserved to reject any and all bids or to waive informalities or defects in bids if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Bangor. Bases of award of Contract is determined by the lowest qualified bidder. **The lowest bidder must have successfully completed a Highway, or project specific prequalification for Bangor to consider the award of this contract.**
