The following question has been received:

**Question:** Please verify the actual location / street address of the two buildings to be taken down for the DOT at the Edgcomb and Jefferson sites?

**Response:** Please ref page 35 of the Bid Book for 911 Physical Address of buildings in question.

**Question:** It appears that Unit 7 (B35847) on the Greene site has already been taken down; would you please confirm this?

**Response:** The Unit 7 (B35847) on the Greene site has not been taken down. This building is located at the rear of the lot, behind the other existing buildings on this site.

**Question:** On page 26, note 4 states that "All Demolition work will not include any concrete walls or floors"? Are there any concrete walls or floors in the two structures in the town of Greene?

**Response:** B35847 has a dirt floor and on wooden skids. B35848 is on a concrete slab

**Question:** Are any of the structures free of asbestos, if so which ones? If not how will the testing & abatement be paid for?

**Response:** No testing has been done. The buildings are just a wooden shell. We require the awarded vendor to dispose of the material at a licensed facility.

**Question:** How and who do we, the contractors, contact in order to visit the various sites?

**Response:** They can Contact Maurice Hinkley for an appointment. 592-3049

**Question:** Please clarify which sites require loam & seed?

**Response:** The Contractor is responsible for loaming and seeding areas that are damaged as a result of their work, as determined by the Department.




