NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS - PREFERRED EMPLOYEES

Sec. 1303. Public Works; minimum wage

In the employment of laborers in the construction of public works, including state highways, by the State or by persons contracting for the construction, preference must first be given to citizens of the State who are qualified to perform the work to which the employment relates and, if they can not be obtained in sufficient numbers, then to citizens of the United States. Every contract for public works construction must contain a provision for employing citizens of this State or the United States. The hourly wage and benefit rate paid to laborers employed in the construction of public works, including state highways, may not be less than the fair minimum rate as determined in accordance with section 1308. Any contractor who knowingly and willfully violates this section is subject to a fine of not less than \$250 per employee violation. Within 14 days, the Department will review the Apparent Low Bidder's Safety Plan. The Department will review a Project and Site Specific Safety Plan to evaluate if the Bidder has a reasonable understanding of job hazards of the expected contract work, has determined preventive measures to overcome these hazards and understands that the work is to be conducted in compliance with this special provision, Contract requirements and all applicable Federal, State, and local laws governing safety including all applicable laws and regulations of OSHA. The Department reserves the right to communicate in writing with Bidders, if needed, to obtain additions to and/or clarification of information contained in the submittals received. Review by the Department, comments by the Department, or any failure to review or comment, shall not absolve the Contractor of its responsibility to develop and implement a Safety Plan in accordance with the Contract, or to shift any responsibility to the Department. The Bidder shall have 3 days to submit

additions, changes and clarifications. Following this 3 (three) day period, the Bidder will have no additional opportunity to submit, modify or clarify information. The Department will not provide an opportunity for the Bidder to meet. .If the Department and the Apparent Successful Bidder agree, an extension beyond the 3 days may occur and in such case, there shall also be an equivalent or greater extension beyond the 30 days of the Bid and Bid Prices specified in Standard Specification Section 103.4 Notice of Intent to Award and the Bid remains viable. In no case shall these extensions change the specified Contract Completion Date.

Based on these submissions, the Department will make one of the following determinations:

- 1. Qualified The Contractor has satisfied the post-bid, pre-award Safety Plan requirements, however, the Contractor may still be required to make minor revisions to the Safety Plan prior to starting on site work.
- 2. Not Qualified Bidder is not qualified to properly carry out the terms of the Contract and/or the submission does not meet specifications and accepted standards and is not acceptable, as determined by the Department.

The Department reserves the right to suspend the work at any time and request a meeting to discuss violations and remedies. 1st Incident: If the Contractor has previously received a verbal warning for the same or similar unsafe conditions or does not take corrective action immediately upon receipt of verbal warning, the Department will issue a written warning.

2nd Incident: The Department may (A) give written Notice of Default to the Contractor and immediately terminate the Contract by written Notice of Termination, or (B) take prosecution of the Work away from the Contractor without violating the Contract. The specified per diem rate for Liquidated Damages is \$500.00 per calendar day. All Work must be Complete by each Completion Date, as specified in the Contract, and any authorized extensions. The Contractor shall owe the Department Liquidated Damages for every day past each Completion Date the Work is not complete. This amount will be deducted from any money due the Contractor under the Contract, and the Contractor will be liable for any Liquidated Damages in excess of the amount due.

For every Calendar day beyond June 11, 2019, the crushing in Lang Township, Rangeley Sand & Gravel Pit is not complete, the Contractor will be charged \$500 in Supplemental Liquidated Damages. This assessment of Supplemental Liquidated Damages will be in addition to the Liquidated Damages specified in Section 107 of the Standard Specifications.

By executing the Contract, the Contractor acknowledges the difficulty of making a precise determination of damages due to completing the work beyond the designated completion dates, acknowledges that such an amount is not a penalty, agrees to the amount stipulated in the contract that will be charged against the Contractor for each calendar day that the work remains uncompleted after each designated completion date, agrees that the daily amount set forth in the Contract is a reasonable per diem forecast of damages incurred by the Department due to the Contractor's failure to Complete the

Work by the Completion Dates, and agrees to stipulate to their reasonableness in any suit for the collection of or involving the assessment of said damages. The damages referred to herein are intended to be and are cumulative, and will be in addition to every other remedy now or hereafter enforceable at law, in equity, by statute, or under the contract. Description The Contractor shall crush the Hot Bituminous Pavement and other similar material in the stockpiles designated by the Department so that the maximum aggregate size of the finished product does not exceed 34" square. During the crushing process, the Contractor shall uniformly blend stock piles. The Contractor shall not add water to the material in the crushing process unless authorized by the Department. Contractor shall construct stockpiles such that equipment is not driven onto freshly crushed pile. The minimum pile height shall be 25 feet at the top of a completed pile in its final location. ready for measurement, unless otherwise directed by the Department. Due to limited storage area at these stockpile locations, a conveyor shall be required to stack the final product higher than normal to insure the Pugmill operations will have adequate space for their operations. The Contractor shall stack the processed RAP in a stockpile (or stockpiles) with the top of the pile shaped as to not trap water or drain directly back into the processed pile. The Contractor will minimize travel over the stockpile. 102.11.2 Curable Bid Defects Add the following after 102.11.2 E:
