Prequalification application materials for many consultant services have been removed from the Internet. New prequalification application documents will be made available upon completion of MaineDOT's prequalification review of all RFQ submittals, on or about February 1, 2013. **Requests for prequalification (except for certain property services) will not be accepted until after these new application documents are posted.**

A more complete view of our estimated timeline for the Department-wide RFQ process follows below:

- September 5, 2012 – post RFQ on MaineDOT Consultant Information web site
- October 5, 2012 (*approx. 4 weeks after posting*) – consultant submittal deadline
- February 1, 2013 – Program Areas have completed prequalification evaluations and an updated list of prequalified consultants is posted, along with new prequalification application materials
- April 30, 2013 – new General Consultant Agreements are completed and signed
