### **TITLE VI PROGRAM – RECIPIENTS SERVING URBANIZED AREAS WITH POPULATIONS OF 200,000 PEOPLE OR GREATER**

Chapter V: FTA Circular 4702 1A Program-Specific Requirements and Guidelines for Recipients Serving Large Urbanized Areas. *All recipients providing service to geographic areas with 200,000 people or greater should submit the following information to the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) as part of their Title VI Program.*

As of March, 2009, the State of Maine has no geographic urbanized area with a population of 200,000 or greater under 49 U.S.C. 5307. Should the next Census determine that the State of Maine has gained an urbanized geographic area with a population of 200,000 or greater it will require the subrecipient of such to comply with all program requirements set forth in Chapter IV and V of Title VI.
