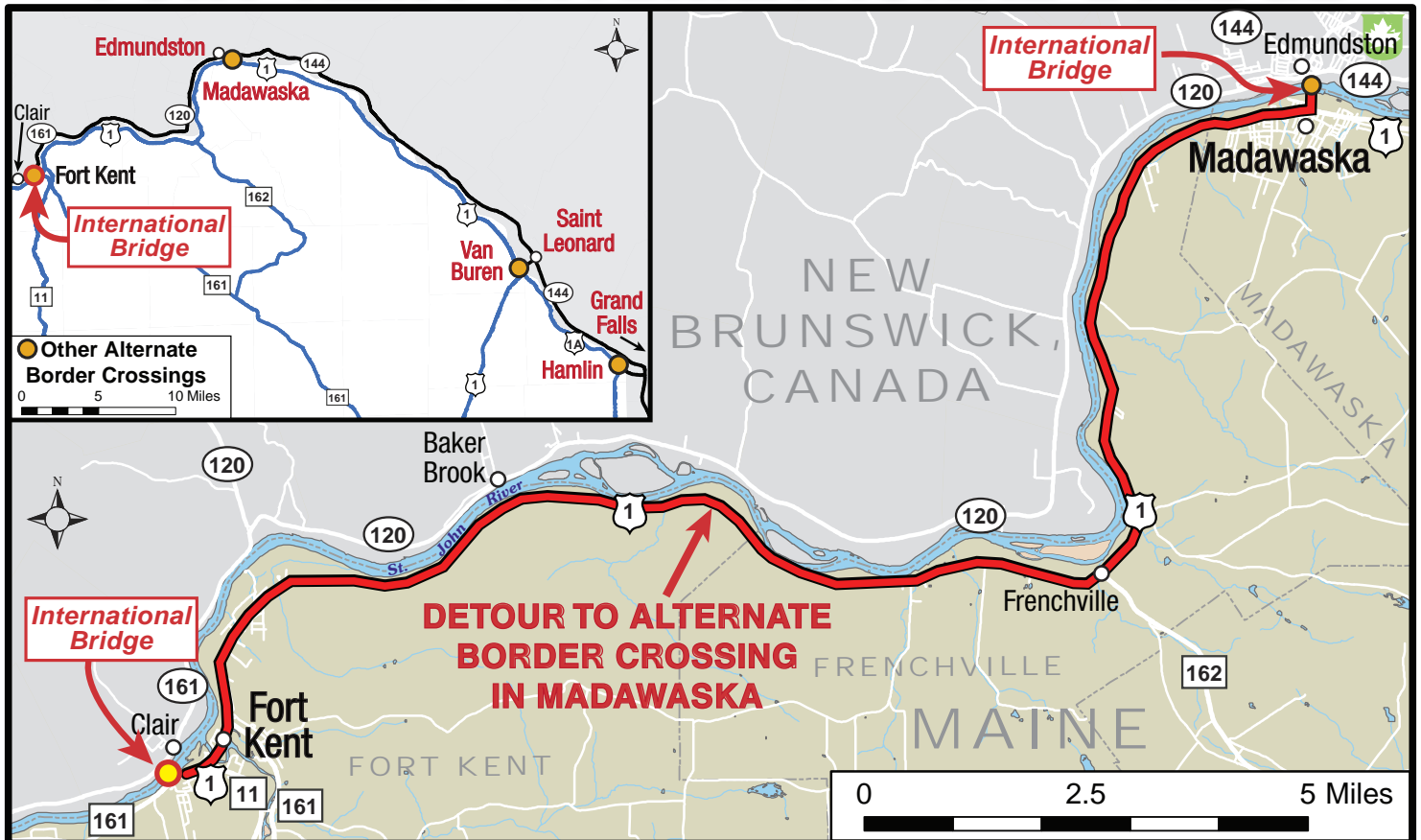


TRAFFIC ALERT

VEHICLE RESTRICTIONS ON THE FORT KENT INTERNATIONAL BRIDGE



Due to ongoing construction, the Fort Kent International Bridge will be limiting passage of oversized vehicles. Contractor activities in May, June and July involve booth and canopy construction which severely limits the maneuverability of oversized vehicles attempting to cross. Large trucks are encouraged to use alternate routes including the border crossing at Madawaska.

JUNE 16th through JULY 13th: Vehicles measuring 9 feet wide by 12 feet high and 22 feet long will not be allowed on the bridge. This is for both inbound and outbound traffic.

JULY 15th through JULY 28th: Vehicles **ENTERING** the United States are limited to those smaller than 9 feet wide by 12 feet high and 22 feet long. Vehicles **LEAVING** the United States to enter Canada must be shorter than 49 feet.

The new bridge will be fully open to traffic by July 31st. There will be **NO CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY** from August 8th to August 24th while the World Acadian Congress is under way.

We regret this inconvenience and encourage you to allow extra time and drive safely along any alternate route you may choose.
