JOB DESCRIPTION: The individual filling this position serves aboard all MSFS vessels, as assigned by the Port Captain, in the absence of the regularly assigned ferry able seamen. Duties include, but are not limited to, the following: Cleans and maintains passageways and compartments on or above the main deck; handles mooring lines during docking/undocking operations; verifies and collects boarding tickets and assists in the loading/unloading of passengers and vehicles including chocking/unchocking of vehicle wheels; cleans/paints interior and exterior vessel structure, gear, and equipment; actively participates in safety drills and operations including the swinging out, lowering, handling, and retrieval of lifeboats; stands helm and lookout watches in wheelhouse; and performs security duties i.a.w. the Vessel Security Plan. Applicant must possess a valid U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariners Document (MMD) with AB endorsement (unlimited, limited, or special) and a TWIC (Transportation Workers Identification Credential). The applicant selected for hire must submit to and pass pre-employment drug screening as outlined in 49CFR Part 40. Applicant must be physically capable of performing all duties of Ferry Able Seaman and, at the Department’s discretion, submit to and pass pre-employment physical.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Experience as a deck crewmember of vessels operating on ocean or coastal routes, a U.S. Coast Guard certificate (MMD) as able seaman (unlimited, limited, or special), and a TWIC (Transportation Workers Identification Credential).
- The applicant selected for hire must submit to and pass pre-employment drug screening as outlined in 49CFR Part 40.
- Must provide and wear safety boots while in work status, which meets the ANSI standard and which are at least six (6) inches in height.
