Conditional on the contractor avoiding an area indicated in red on the attached plan photocopy based on the plans dated June, 2013 by Gorrill-Palmer Consulting Engineers that you hand-delivered to our office last week, and based on our archaeological field work for this project accomplished this spring, it is extremely unlikely that a significant archaeological site would be affected by this project, in our opinion. In following the procedures specified in the Federal Highway/MHPC/MDOT programmatic agreement, we recommend a finding "that there will be no archaeological properties affected by the proposed undertaking" if the contract for the work contains an exclusion area as indicated west of the interstate and south of Trafton Road.'
