Please join MaineDOT on Wednesday, December 2, 2009, at a preliminary public meeting to discuss the future replacement of the Jenkins Bridge, (#3365), which carries Cram Street over the Great Works Stream, in Bradley.

Representatives of the Maine Department of Transportation will be present at 6:00 p.m. to listen to concerns, receive comments, and answer questions from anyone with an interest in the project. The Department would like to discuss bridge replacement options as well as traffic detour options. In particular, the use of Cross Road as a potential detour during construction will be discussed.
