The Maine Department of Transportation (MaineDOT) is seeking public comment on the following project to be considered for inclusion in the federally required 2014-2017 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP):

PIN 018915.00 – BREWER-EDDINGTON, I-395/RT. 9 CONNECTOR – Preliminary Engineering and Right of Way - Beginning approximately 0.25 of a mile west of I-395 with Route 1A, roughly paralleling the Brewer/Holden town line, extending approximately 6 miles to Route 9 west of Chemo Pond Road (in the vicinity of Lois Lane). Funding: \$250,000.
