WHEREAS, in the past excavators have failed to request line locations because of the number of calls required to notify the many utility companies whose facilities might be involved; and



NOW, THEREFORE, I, PAUL R. LEPAGE, Governor of the State of Maine, do hereby recognize April, 2014 as


SAFE DIGGING MONTH
