CHAPTER 870: Late Payment Charges, Interest Rates to be Paid on Customer Deposits and Charges for Returned Checks

STATUTORY AUTHORITY: 35-A M.R.S. §§ 101, 104, 111, 301, 304, and 705(3)

PURPOSE: To amend the rule to establish a just and reasonable interest rate for customer deposits
