

Application Process for Certificate of Authority in Maine

The Maine Bureau of Insurance only accepts Uniform Certificate of Authority Application (UCAA) which are available from the NAIC website. Certificates of Authority are issued in accordance with Regulation 231, which replaced Regulation 230 effective August 9, 2005. Maine has no additional state specific information to be submitted with the UCAA application.

*****Please note that, as of August 9, 2005, a preliminary application in Maine is no longer required.*****
