The Plumbers' Examining Board recently adopted the 2015 edition of the Uniform Plumbing Code. The Board also adopted several amendments to the code. The Board staff will be conducting several training sessions to update all plumbers on the recent changes to the Code. Although this training is not mandatory, the Board strongly suggests that journeyman and master plumbers take advantage of this opportunity.

The training dates and times are listed on the attachment. We have many sessions scheduled for October, November, and December.
