

Agreement dated 10/9/2007, between Webber Energy Fuels and Agency named above, is hereby amended as follows:

1. The Scope of Work is modified to add: The vendor will extend same terms to other governmental units where available. Local government units to approach vendor separately to finalize terms by calling Chris Brook at 207-992-5133.
2. The Term of the Agreement will end on September 30, 2009 and may be extended for up to one additional year with the mutual agreement of the parties
3. Lock in prices below (fully burdened cost) with 178,988 gallons of #2 oil from October 1, 2008 to April 1, 2009. In the event that there is any unutilized #2 oil, it will be reallocated by the vendor at no charge to the state. If locked in gallons are exceeded or for order before October or after April, pricing will revert back to original agreement until end of contract.
