

4. The parties have agreed to enter into this Consent Agreement to resolve this matter.

COVENANTS

In order to resolve fully the complaint against Mr. Babb's establishment license without further legal proceedings, it is agreed to among the parties that:

1. Mr. Babb admits that he violated 32 M.R.S.A. § 14224(1) and agrees to accept a FORMAL REPRIMAND from the Board as sanction for that violation;
2. Mr. Babb agrees to pay a fine of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) as sanction for said violation, which is to be paid by **CERTIFIED CHECK OR MONEY ORDER** made payable to "Treasurer, State of Maine" and is to be remitted to Cathy Bitz, Board Clerk, Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, 35 State House Station, Augusta, Maine 04333-0035 at the time Mr. Babb submits this signed Consent Agreement;
3. Upon receipt of the signed Consent Agreement and the fine payment, the Board agrees to issue Mr. Babb's establishment license, contingent upon his meeting all other eligibility conditions for licensure;
4. The Attorney General and the Board agree that no further agency or legal action will be taken against Mr. Babb's establishment license based on the facts described herein, except in the event that Mr. Babb does not comply fully with the terms of the Consent Agreement. Any violation of the Consent Agreement will be a ground for discipline by the Board;
5. The Consent Agreement is not subject to appeal;


6. The Consent Agreement is not subject to amendment except by written agreement of all parties;

7. The Consent Agreement is a public document within the meaning of 1 M.R.S.A. § 402, et seq.;

8. Mr. Babb understands that the execution of this Consent Agreement is completely voluntary and that he has the right to consult with an attorney before signing the Consent Agreement; and


9. Mr. Babb understands that his signature indicates that he has read and understands this Consent Agreement and that he enters into it of his own free will.


