) CONSENT AGREEMENT
)

PARTIES

1. This is a Consent Agreement regarding the license of Deshawn Stubbs to work as an electrician within the State of Maine. The parties to this Consent Agreement are Deshawn Stubbs ("the licensee"); the Electricians' Examining Board ("the Board"); and the Maine Department of Attorney General ("the Attorney General"). This Consent Agreement is entered into pursuant to 10 MRSA §8003(5)(A-1) and (B).

FACTS

2. On June 11, 2007, Deshawn Stubbs applied for a license to the Board.

3. Deshawn Stubbs willfully failed to fully disclose on the application that he was convicted of the following crime(s):

- Class E, Theft by Unauthorized Taking or Transfer on 11/21/00
- Class E, Violating Condition of Release on 11/21/00
- Class E, Negotiating a Worthless Instrument on 5/9/02

VIOLATION

4. Title 32 MRSA §1155-A(2) provides in relevant part that "the board may refuse to issue or renew a license or the District Court may suspend or revoke a license of any licensed person who is found guilty of ... the practice of fraud or deceit in obtaining a license or permit."

5. The licensee admits that his non-disclosure of the above-mentioned conviction on the application dated June 11, 2007 constituted the practice of fraud or deceit in obtaining a license in violation of 32 MRSA §1155-A(2).

PENALTY

6. As discipline for this violation, the licensee shall pay a civil penalty of \$50.00 no later than July 25, 2007.

7. If the licensee fails to pay this amount in full by the due date, the licensee understands that a license will not be issued.


8. This Consent Agreement is not appealable and remains in effect until modified or rescinded in writing by the parties.
