SECOND AMENDED
CONSENT AGREEMENT

Introduction

Pursuant to paragraph seventeen of the consent agreement and paragraph six of the first amended consent agreement entered into by and between Peter Davis (“Mr. Davis” or “Licensee”); the Board of Examiners on Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology (the “Board”); and the Maine Office of the Attorney General (the “Attorney General”), the parties enter into this second amended consent agreement.

Facts

1. In October 2006, Mr. Davis entered into a consent agreement with the Board and the Attorney General.
2. In April 2007, Mr. Davis entered into an amended consent agreement with the Board and the Attorney General.
3. By letter dated July 18, 2007, Mr. Davis requested further amendment of his consent agreement.
4. At its September 17, 2007 meeting, the Board voted to offer this second amended consent agreement to Licensee to resolve this complaint.

5. The Board has reviewed the provider reports and determined that they document that the Licensee has achieved the goals of counseling, as set forth in and required by the consent agreement and amended consent agreement.

Covenants

6. Mr. Davis shall be seen by the provider in accordance with his July 18th letter; that is, he shall be counseled for two additional sessions as follows: once before treating his first minor patient and at least once after he completes his first treatment session with a minor.

7. The provider shall submit written reports to the Board, detailing the two counseling sessions required by the above paragraph, setting forth whether Licensee has demonstrated the goals of counseling, as set forth in the consent agreement and amended consent agreement.


8. Compliance with the above covenants shall be in lieu of the further counseling and self-reporting originally set forth in the consent agreement.

9. All other terms and conditions of the consent agreement not specifically modified herein shall remain in full force and effect.


10. Licensee understands that execution of this amended agreement is completely voluntary and that he has the right to consult with an attorney before signing the consent agreement.

11. Licensee understands that his signature indicates that: he has read and understands this amended consent agreement; he enters into the agreement on its own free will; and he agrees to abide by all terms and conditions set forth herein.


