CONSENT AGREEMENT

PARTIES

1. This is a Consent Agreement regarding Jeremy McInnis' license to work as plumber within the State of Maine. The parties to this Consent Agreement are Jeremy McInnis ("the licensee"); the Plumbers' Examining Board ("the Board"); and the Maine Department of Attorney General ("the Attorney General"). This Consent Agreement is entered into pursuant to 10 MRSA §8003(5)(A-1) and (B).

FACTS

2. On October 15, 1999 Jeremy McInnis applied for a license to the Board.

3. Jeremy McInnis willfully failed to disclose on the application that he was convicted of the following crime(s):

8/24/88 Criminal Mischief

4. On the strength of this application, license #TR90009001 was issued to ~~Richard~~ McInnis.

5. This license is in effect today, and ~~Richard~~ McInnis is a licensee of the board.

VIOLATION

6. Title 32 MRSA §3404(1) provides in relevant part that "the board may refuse to issue or renew a license or the District Court may suspend, revoke or refuse to renew the license of any licensee who is found guilty of...the practice of any fraud or deceit in obtaining a license."

7. The licensee admits that his non-disclosure of the above-mentioned conviction on the application dated October 15, 1999 constituted the practice of fraud or deceit in obtaining a license in violation of 32 MRSA §3404(1).

PENALTY

8. As discipline for this violation, the licensee shall pay a civil penalty of \$250 no later than October 2, 2001.
9. If the licensee fails to pay this amount in full by the due date, the licensee understands that—
- The Board may refuse to renew the licensee's license; and
 - An action to recover the amount due may be brought against the licensee in Superior Court.


MISCELLANEOUS

10. This Consent Agreement is not appealable and remains in effect until modified or rescinded in writing by the parties.
11. The Board and the Attorney General may communicate and cooperate regarding any matter relating to this Consent Agreement.
12. This Consent Agreement is a public record as defined in 1 MRSA §402 and is available for inspection and copying by the public pursuant to 1 MRSA §408.
13. The licensee acknowledges by his signature below that he has read this Consent Agreement, that he has had an opportunity to consult with an attorney before executing this Consent Agreement, that he executed this Consent of his own free will, and that he agrees to abide by the terms of this Consent Agreement.
