BRIEF *SUMMARY: The Department is proposing to issue negative declarations for the Large Appliance Coatings and Automobile and Light-Duty Truck Assembly Coatings Control Technique Guidelines (CTG) categories. After reviewing our inventory of sources for facilities with North American Industrial Classification System (NAICS) codes that correspond to these source categories, interviewing field and compliance staff, and searching telephone and business directories, we have determined that there are no sources in Maine meeting the applicability thresholds for either of these CTG categories. Since there are no sources subject to these federal control requirements, the issuance of a negative declaration will eliminate unnecessary rulemaking. Pursuant to Maine law, interested parties are publicly notified of the proposed rulemaking and are provided an opportunity for comment. Written comments may be submitted by mail, e-mail or fax to the contact person before the end of the comment period. To ensure the comments are considered, they must include your name and the organization you represent, if any. Although the Department has not scheduled a public hearing on this proposal, a public hearing will be scheduled if any requests are received prior to the close of the public comment period.
